# Erasmus +

---

## Some **trends** in Erasmus+

- Closer link between **policy** and practice
- Encouraged **cross-sectorial** cooperation
- **More synergies** between formal, non-formal and informal learning
- Stronger **international** dimension

## Key Actions

- KA1: Individual Mobility
    - Improved competences & increased capacity
  - KA2: Cooperation for innovation and exchange of good practices
    - Strategic Partnerships
    - Capacity Building
  - KA3: Support for policy reforms

# The Third Health Programme

---

- with a planned budget of **449 million €**
  - It is the main instrument that the Commission uses to implement the **EU Health Strategy**
  - **Annual work plans** of the Programme set out priority areas and the criteria for its funding actions
-

# The Third Health Programme

---

The programme has 4 overarching objectives which seek to:

- Promote health, prevent diseases and foster supportive environments for healthy lifestyles taking into account the '**health in all policies**' principle
  - Contribute to **innovative, efficient and sustainable health systems**
  - **Facilitate access to better and safer healthcare** for Union citizens
  - Protect EU citizens from cross-border health threats
-

# Horizon 2020

---

- with a planned budget of **80 billion €**
  - is the new programme for **research and innovation**
  - more opportunities for **Third Country participation**, aiming to [international research cooperation](#)
  - Having built H2020 around the main **societal challenges** like an ageing population, food security, energy efficiency, the EU attaches high importance to integrate [social sciences and humanities](#) into the work programme
-

# Horizon 2020

---

- Complex & articulated
  - Several calls per year
  - Typically for 2/3 year projects and up to 5 years
  - For an average budget of 2/3 million € up to 4/5 million
  - No co-funding required
  - All on line – no signature required to apply
-
